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## **Food Vendors**

Submit a copy of your current Health Department permit/inspection **OR** written documentation (email or letter) from the appropriate regulatory agency stating that your products do not require a permit or inspection.

If selling a food item that does not require an inspection, include the following with the application correspondence:

- A list of ingredients on packaged foods.
- Labels that comply with North Carolina state requirements.
- Whether the food is prepared in a Commercial or Home Kitchen.
- The name and address of the kitchen or facility where the food is prepared.

**Applications for food vendors will NOT be considered complete without the required documentation. It is the vendor's responsibility to obtain and maintain any required permits, licenses, or approvals necessary to sell their products.**
